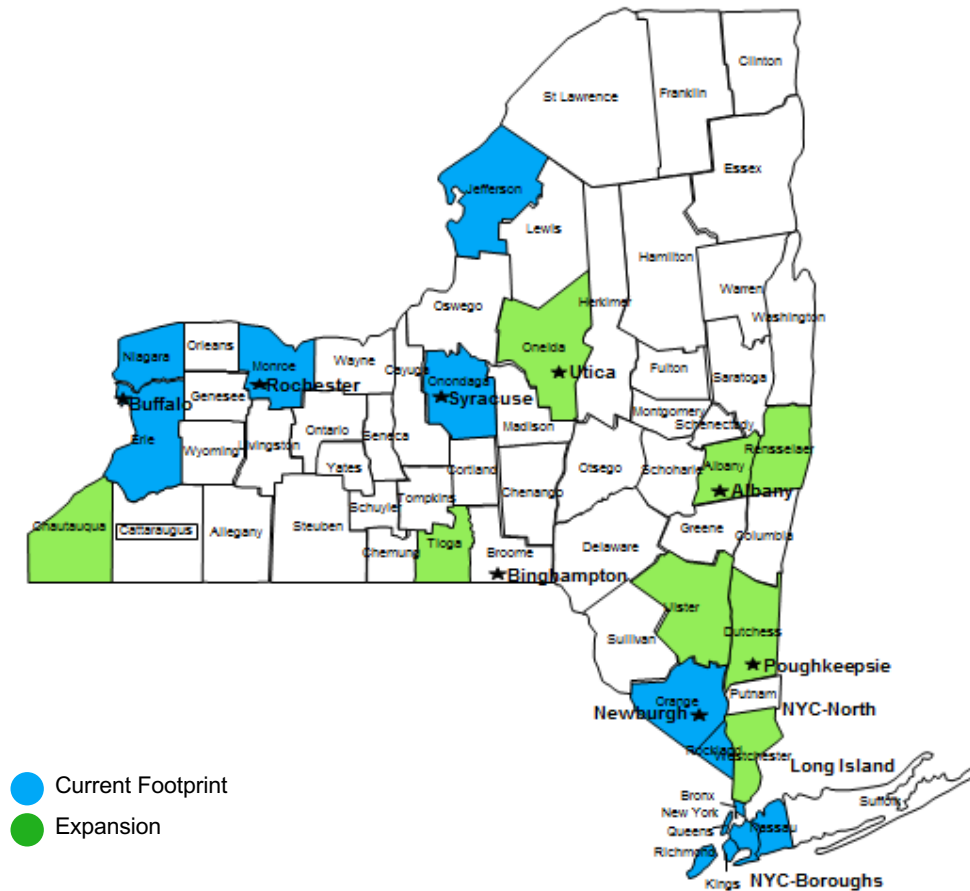

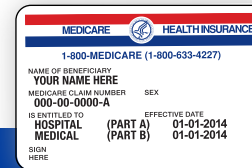

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## Additional Benefits\*

	<b>OTC Debit Card</b>	●	Debit card for retail use: \$125/month → \$1,500/year; monthly expiration
	<b>Dental</b>	●	\$3,000 annually; covers implants, fixed bridgework, full and partial dentures and root canals
	<b>Vision</b>	●	Annual exam and \$300 credit every two years for eyewear
	<b>Hearing</b>	●	Annual exam and \$2,000 credit every two years for hearing devices
	<b>Transportation</b>	●	48 one-way rides for health care visits and prescription needs
	<b>NurseLine</b>	●	Available 24 hours a day/7 days a week
	<b>PERS</b>	●	Personal Emergency Response System (PERS) available 24 hours a day/7 days a week at no additional cost — service includes wireless/landline compatibility, assisted or self-set-up and available anywhere in the U.S.
	<b>Acupuncture</b>	●	Acupuncture services covered; up to 20 visits for \$0 per visit
	<b>Meal Program</b>	●	\$0 co-pay for up to 2 weeks meals following discharge from a facility one time per year
