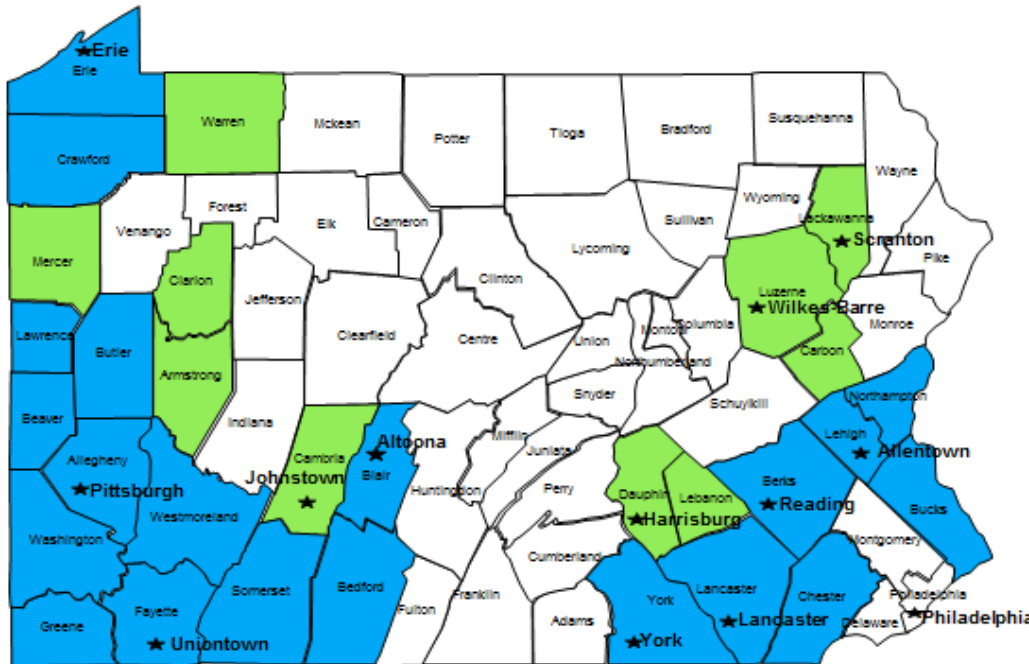

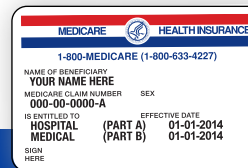

 OTC Credits	●	Member-facing catalog: \$190/quarter → \$760/year; annual expiration
 OTC Debit Card	●	Debit card for retail use: \$75/quarter → \$300/year; annual expiration
 Dental	●	\$2,500 annually; covers exams, x-rays, cleanings, fillings, crowns, periodontal services, extractions, oral/maxillofacial surgery, root canals, partial dentures and more
 Vision	●	Annual exam and \$150 credit every year for eyewear
 Hearing	●	Annual exam and \$1,000 credit every two years for hearing devices
 Transportation	●	48 one-way rides for health care visits and prescription needs
